

ENGLISH VERSION

You can now apply to have a spot for Distortion's street party with a bar or food stall (F&B host), and thereby the opportunity to serve food or drinks to thousands of guests. We are looking for stalls with a sharp concept, a high level of service and would also like to see that you have the environmental aspect in mind.

We strive to have a wide range of food and bars that specialize in their own area. In doing so, we also ensure that internal competition between the stalls is minimized.

This year it will be possible to apply for a place for the following:

1 June 2023: Street party, Vesterbro, 16.00-22.00

2 June 2023: Garden party, Refshaleøen, 15.00-21.00

Applications are NOT open for bars for Distortion Ø or Distortion X.

LOCATIONS AND PRICE CATEGORIES

There are varying stall prices depending on where you are located and what type of stall you are. They are ranked in categories A, A+ and A++ where the most attractive rankings (A++) are also the most expensive. The price level reflects the potential turnover that bars and food stalls have achieved in previous years, and it is based on a fixed limited location area of max 5.5x3 sales meters. In order to meet placement requests as best as possible, we encourage you to apply for 3 locations in priority order.

If your stall is larger than 5.5x3 meters, the application requires a separate layout plan. In other words, a drawing with precise measurements of the equipment being set up. An additional space fee per meter of DKK 1,500 is added. Distortion strives to meet the wishes, but points out that the municipality's Technical and Environmental Administration may raise objections to the submitted layout.

Price categories for bars for Vesterbro and Refshaleøen:

A location: 8.000 kr

A+ location: DKK 14,000

A++ location: DKK 25,000

Price categories for food stalls for Vesterbro and Refshaleøen:

A location: 4.000 kr

A+ location: DKK 6,000

A++ location: 9.000 kr

Price categories for snack stalls (popcorn, chips, ice cream, etc.) (max size of 2.5x1.5 meters) to Vesterbro and Refshaleøen:

A and A+ location: DKK 1,000

A++ location: DKK 2,000

Price categories for coffee stalls (max size of 2.5x1.5 meters) for Vesterbro and Refshaleøen:

A and A+ location: DKK 1,500

A++ location: DKK 3,000

Price for food stalls for Distortion X and Ø:

Fixed fee of DKK 2,500 + 20% of revenue. Distortion delivers payment solution with Dankort-machine, from which the total revenue is calculated. Write to fooddrinks@cphdistortion.dk for more info.

Although there are many possible locations in Vesterbro, it is not the same as all have been taken into use. We review all applicants and only select a certain number of stalls. We therefore do not place 10 coffee trucks next to each other, even if there were as many applications.

Please be aware that there are only a few stalls available on Refshaleøen.

Street activities

To give an idea of what is going on at Vesterbro, the activities are generally divided into the following areas:

Enghaveparken: Children's Distortion

Istedgade: Long table dinner

Sønder Boulevard and side streets: Music and dance activities

Otto Krabbes Plads: DogDistortion

At Refshaleøen, the possible application areas primarily include music activities.

The stall price covers...

- Visibility and exposure on Distortion's platform, as well as placement on Distortion's festival map.
- Distortion is responsible for coordination with all involved public authorities.

- Distortion provides barrier plans, sets up signs, toilet facilities, security, etc.
- Distortion helps in obtaining the relevant permits.
- Distortion takes care of the final cleaning task when the street party is well over.

TERMS AND OBLIGATIONS

- Food stalls may only sell food and bars may only sell drinks/cocktails.
- Bars may not sell any beer or energy drinks.
- Bars can use soft drinks and energy drinks in their cocktails or drinks, but the brand must not be marketed in the stall, nor can the name of the cocktail/drink contain the brand name – think in unique and creative names.
- Third party exposure/sponsorship agreements are not allowed.
- You may ONLY market your own product and company info.
- Setting up your bar/food stall must be done between 10:00 and 15:00 both days.
- Packing of equipment must be finished by 11:30 p.m. both days. Street cleaning starts at 24:00, so it is important that your stall along with your waste is cleared out of the way.

Alcohol license and control report

Bars: All bars must have a licensed holder present. A special alcohol license (Lejlighedstilladelse) must be applied for for serving alcohol on the day. This license must have the responsible licensee or manager of the associated restaurant on board.

The license must be sent to Distortion no later than March 30.

Food stalls: All food stalls must have a hygiene certificate/control report before Distortion can approve the stall. Please attach the document when filling out the application form or send to fooddrinks@cphdistortion.dk. Please write in the subject line "company/food stall name" and "inspection report/certificate".

Electricity

- For the street parties, you have to provide electricity and water and connect this yourself.
- If you're assigned a space at Distortion Ø there is 1 x 13A, 1 phase 230V power source included in the price. There is no water connection, but there is access to fresh water. If you need more, this can be purchased at an affordable price.

Think green

Distortion tries to incorporate an environmentally correct way of thinking at several parts of the festival. We therefore encourage all bars and food stalls to think green in their approach when selling food and drinks on the street. The following guidelines have been drawn up:

- We encourage the use of biodegradable packaging, paper cups/plates/knives/forks, recycled napkins, NO plastic straws, return cups/buckets and minimal glass for safety reasons.
- If you need an environmentally friendly supplier for packaging or serving materials, please contact us at fooddrinks@cphdistortion.dk, as we can help you with this – not only for this festival, but also in the future.
- As for drinking containers, it should not exceed 1 liter in volume, and it should not be hard plastic material! Buckets MUST have a deposit system associated with a minimum of DKK 20 per bucket.
- It is recommended that you have some kind of logo or branding on a bucket so that you know if the bucket is purchased in your bar.
- You are responsible for your own waste and must take this with you when packing up after the festival to ensure that the area around your stall is clean. Wasted should be cleared within a radius of 15 meters from the stall. For your own sake, we advise you to sort your waste into the different categories mentioned above. It is recommended to take photo documentation before and after the event.

DEADLINES

- 1. March: Applications for bars and food stalls larger than 5.5x3 meters. Layout plan required.
- 25. March: Applications for bars and food stalls for designated locations of 5.5x3 meters.
- 30. March: Alcohol license (bars only) filled out and submitted.
- 10. April: Contract signed.
- 2. May: Payment deadline for 50% of the location expenses + deposit.
- 24. May: Payment deadline for the last 50% of the location costs.
